

Research integrity at i3S Checklist

As a leading portuguese Research Institute in Health Sciences, i₃S attaches great importance to responsible conduct in research, which means that pressure to perform should never lead to lack of attention for the way in which our research is conducted. Compliance with legislation is a must and work needs to be done in a safe way. Moreover, ethical questions are seriously taken and high integrity standards have to be upheld. Below you can find i₃S Research Integrity Checklist with the main topics of responsible research and the corresponding reference to documents/web links that will help you to deal with the practical, ethical, and intellectual challenges you may encounter.

ASPECT OF RESEARCH INTEGRITY:

Code of ethics

Acknowledge the National and European codes and comply with their provisions in all stages of the research.

ASPECT OF RESEARCH INTEGRITY:

Training

Attend i₃S wide lecture on Research Integrity (compulsory for all new doctoral researchers) that will be offered several times during the academic year.

Senior researchers, research leaders and supervisors are also expected to update their knowledge on research ethics/integrity throughout their career and take training in leadership.

ASPECT OF RESEARCH INTEGRITY:

Authorship

Discuss authorship throughout the project, especially prior to work being prepared or submitted for publication. Discuss the general requirements for a person to be attributed as an author of a publication. Agree on authorship and attribution for each publication and confirm the list of co-authors with all the group involved in the publication.

Each alteration in the author list should be approved by all authors.

Plagiarism

Discuss what constitutes plagiarism and how to avoid unintentional plagiarism.

Discuss how any potential conflicts associated with the research might be identified, declared and managed.

Supervising

All researchers are required to know the values, principles and rules regarding responsible research supervision that are clearly outlined in the following documents:

ASPECT OF RESEARCH INTEGRITY:

Ethical requirements

All projects carried out at i3S have to be given appraisal by the <u>Committee for Ethical and Responsible</u> <u>Conduct of Research</u> (CECRI) - if human subjects or human material are involved - or or by the <u>Animal Welfare and Ethics Review Body</u> (ORBEA) - if vertebrate animals are involved.

ASPECT OF RESEARCH INTEGRITY:

Requirements if processing personal data

Discuss under which conditions personal data may be collected and processed
