

i3S Fundraising Cancer Travel Grant by TabFund



Article 1. Scope

The i3S Fundraising team awards a Travel Grant, sponsored by TabFund (<https://tab.fund/>), for i3S researchers working in the field of Cancer. The grant aims to help promising researchers attend an international scientific meeting (conference, workshops or similar events) of their choice.

Article 2. Eligibility

Applicants must be i3S PhD students.

Article 3. Coverage

Summer schools (or similar), Workshops, Conferences or Symposia in Portugal or abroad. In case of travel costs, this grant can only be used to cover economy travel. Visa, accommodation and subsistence costs will not be covered by these funds. The maximum covered value is 500 € and may also include registration fees.

Article 4. Deadlines

Applications will be open from 15th March to 15th April. The Travel grant will be awarded to support attendance to an event with dates from April 2023 until December 2024. In case the person is not accepted in the event, he/she must notify the organization and the grant will be attributed to 2nd place candidate.

Article 5. Submission of application

Application must be submitted through the i3S platform <https://www.i3s.up.pt/eventos/registrationnew.php?eid=817>.

Article 6. Evaluation of the applications

The applications will be evaluated individually by the jury considering the following parameters:

- Work to be presented (Abstract and Conference)
- 1 page CV
- Motivation statement describing the importance of the visit and the impact that it will bring to the candidate's career and to i3S community (max. 500 words)
- Referral letter (max. 1 page, valued factor)
